Blessed are You who protected and rescued Avraham, and in his merit You protect us too


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The Theme of the Bracha Who are we praying to? We are praying to the G-d of our forefathers, because we are continuing in their path. Our forefathers discovered the way to create a relationship with Hashem and taught us how to pray.

With this beracha, we pray that Hashem will bring us the Redemption in our forefathers' merit (ie not because we deserve it). At the beginning of the Amidah prayer I ask Hashem to open my mouth in a way that is appropriate for someone standing before Him and to say the words He wants to hear from me. I also prepare my body to face Hashem the King and to approach prayer. That is why I take three steps back and then forward, to come even closer to the Creator of the World.
